This week we continued to study 2D shapes and perimeter in math block. We are learning how to find the missing side length in a rectangle if we are only given the perimeter and width. This is a challenging concept and we will continue to practice this throughout the school year. The concepts that students are practicing on their daily math reviews are a great way to see what your child is expected to know and have mastered as we move throughout the school year.

We also have been trying out two new assessment websites. Third graders will be taking some assessments prior to ISTEP and IREAD in preparation for those assessments as well as to gather data on each students' strengths and areas of concern. We began practicing with PIVOT INSPECT and RAPS360 this week. It is important that we do these practice situations so students feel familiar and comfortable with the technology when it comes time for the true assessment.
