This week has been busy amongst some of the other extras that we took part in as well! We were able to enjoy the Veteran's Day program on Wednesday, as well as the kick off for the Fine Arts fundraiser this week.

We have been busy bees in math this week, continuing our work in multiplication. We worked on multiplying with factors 2-10 this week. Next week, we will take a look at the factors 0 and 1, as well as some of the special properties that pertain to multiplication. We will also begin timed tests soon. This will require students to pass each factor. We will continue to practice our basic facts on Xtra math, while also adding some multiplication practice using a feature on Moby Max. You may notice your child's flashcards changing to multiplication over the course of the next few weeks to ensure they have exposure to this concept as well.

We were able to write an opinion essay this week as well, using what we learned about how to write a persuasive composition. We used the acronym OREO to help us remember the parts of an opinion or persuasive essay. In the acronym OREO, the O's stand for opinion, the R stands for reasons, and the E stands for examples. Encourage your child to give you a reason for the things they choose!
