## Weekly Update

We began working with money in math this week. This included things like finding the value of a collection of coins and bills, as well as creating a collection of coins and bills to show a given amount. This skill is easily practiced at home because you can give your child a collection of real coins and bills and ask them to count the amount given to them. Next week we will begin looking at how we can make purchases with a certain value of money and defending those purchases. Also, please remember to practice your child's math facts each night as we are hoping to be able to begin multiplication facts soon. Your child will have a set of flashcards for a week and then we will trade them out for a new set based on their changing needs.

During reading this week we practiced using the text we have read to assist us in answering comprehension questions. We practiced going back to the text to prove how we know our answer is correct. This skill is useful for students during ISTEP testing because students are presented with a text on ISTEP and asked questions regarding that text, all the while being able to refer back to the text.
