Weekly Update

During reading block this week we have continued to work on finding words with similar beginning, middle, and ending sounds. We have been concentrating on the idea that sounds can be spelled in many different ways. Syllables was another concentration again for this week. While these skills seem like skills for the younger graders, they really do help

students become better independent readers! Within our reading block, we have incorporated project content as well as writing standards. We are currently working on writing a narrative (or story) using knowledge that we learn about our first project! On that note, our first project is focused on how animals communicate using sound. We have been asked to create educational resources that could be used at a zoo to help visitors learn about and understand the ways the different animals communicate.

Throughout math block this week we have worked on our addition and subtraction within word problems. We have created a list of key words that we know <u>usually</u> indicates whether we should add or subtract in a word problem.
