Weekly Update

Please keep encouraging your child to read each night for at least 20 minutes as we are still participating in the WSBT I Love to Read Challenge! We have been doing an exceptional job thus far and I can't wait to see how many minutes we read by the end of the month!

During reading block this week we have been working on sequence of events, and ensuring that we can comprehend how the order of events may affect the events that come next.

Math block has been focusing on fractions still, with an emphasis on equivalent fractions. We rounded up the fraction unit and are beginning a unit on area and perimeter. Perimeter can be easily worked on at home, but asking your child to find the distance around a household object. Encourage students to use a ruler to measure the edges of the object, as we will be using rulers in an upcoming unit of math.
