## Weekly Update

I am so proud of the students and the effort they put in during our IREAD testing. They adjusted to the schedule changes and testing environment like champs!

We were able to get in some regular math and reading lessons in between our schedule changes and IREAD. During math, we began a unit of measuring length. We learned about and applied measuring length to the nearest whole inch, half inch, and quarter inch, as well as to their nearest centimeter. Students were able to compare the ruler to a number line with fractions. You can practice measuring the length of objects around your home to help students practice!

During reading, we practiced analyzing and evaluating the texts that we read. This means we think carefully about what we read and then form our own opinion about it. This skill can be practiced at home by having a conversation about the text your child is reading once they are done!
