It is half way through November and things are going great in 3rd grade! This week we focused our attention on comparing and contrasting during reading block and continued with division during math block.

To practice comparing and contrasting, students used several different stories. We compared and contrasted features like characters, settings, plots, and how those three features affected the entire story. You can practice comparing and contrasting at home without even using a piece of text, simply ask your child to tell you how two or more things are the same and how those things are then different. It would be great to give your child the opportunity to practice the language that is used to compare and contrast, such as "They are the same because..." or "Even though they are similar, they are different because..."

Our efforts have been rooted in division and its relation to multiplication this week. We have included solving read world problems with this as well.
