Some of the items on our agenda for this week were cause and effect, context clues, and using text evidence to support our answers. We will continually practice using context clues throughout our year because this is a life skill that students will need to master to become great readers! To do this, when we come to a word we do not know, we look at all the words around it as well as any illustrations. We use those surrounding words and illustrations to help us determine the meaning of a word. This skill can be practiced at home during your child's 20 minutes of reading. Listen to your child read, and when he or she comes to an interesting or unique word, ask them to tell you what the word means; if they

are unsure, encourage them to use context clues to figure it out! We have begun division during math block this week! Our main goal for the week was to understand that division is taking a large set and breaking it up into smaller, equal groups. We have also been working to understand that multiplication and division are inverse operations.
